Property Tour Join us on a journey into the past through the sacred sights of Keauhou-Kahalu‘u. Tours begin with stories of Ke‘ekū and Hāpaiali‘i heiau to the legacy of King David Kalākaua.

Hawaiian Language Class Learn Hawaiian language fit for all ages. You will learn the basic building blocks of the language and gain an insight into Hawaiian thinking and the melodic style of the language.

Kupuna Arts & Crafts Kupuna (elders) from the West Hawai‘i community share their delicious baked goods, jams, arts, crafts, quilts, lei making, and stories of old Kona. Listen and learn the different traditions of Kona.

Lei Making Experience the finest styles of lei making using native plants, shells and nuts. Learn to make lei in the wili style, ku‘i style and haku style.

Makahiki Games Games of strategy played a large role in the livelihood of the Hawaiian people. During Makahiki season (November to February), these games were used to test the skills of each competitor. Gain insight of specific makahiki games and learn the ancient ways of strategy.

‘Ukulele Hear the sounds of the ocean as you strum your ‘ukulele. Enjoy as you learn songs of old Hawai‘i as well as many current “Hapa-Haole” tunes.

Hula ‘Auana A modern style of hula perpetuated by King David Kalākaua. Understand the history and traditions of Hawai‘i through the beauty of hula and its music. Created for those that would like to stand up at a party and share the art of hula with family and friends.

Chanting Learn and understand the foundation of Hawaiian chanting styles and techniques. Techniques will be shared so you can develop your very own style.

Hula Kahiko Ancient style of hula associated with the history and traditions of Hawai‘i. Learn steps, hand motions and stories told through chant in the ancient style.

Hālau Presentation A gathering of Hawai‘i’s finest hula teachers come and share their style of hula. Guests will gain an appreciation of each teacher’s knowledge, style and understanding of hula.

Monthly Arts and Crafts Fair Arts and crafts items made on Hawai‘i Island to be shared on property with our guests on the last Saturday of every month.
