## Sparkling Wines | Champagne

**Mumm Cordon Rouge 750ml - Champagne, France** 299.0/193.2AUD

A distinctively fresh, full bodied Champagne with a high fruit intensity on the nose with lemon, grapefruit and apple. The mid and back palate showcases intensity and refreshing acidity. A lingering finish.

**Moet & Chandon Brut Imperial 750ml - Champagne, France** 249.0/160.9AUD

Moet and Chandon's flagship, the Brut Imperial's Chardonnay grapes deliver a fruity flavour that is perfectly married with an elegant and complete maturity.

**Jansz NV – Northern Tasmania, Australia** 169.0/109.2AUD

A delicious blend of finesse and balance, complexity and flavour, this aperitif sparkling tastes of nougat, roasted nuts and delicate strawberry.

## Chardonnay

**Vasse Felix Chardonnay – Margaret River, Western Australia** 149.0/96.3AUD

A partial wild yeast fermentation creates an elegant final blend that is rich and textured with parcels of fruit flavours. A true Margaret River delight!

**Wynns Coonawarra Chardonnay – Coonawarra, South Australia** 149.0/96.3AUD

An elegant, melon-flavoured Chardonnay with soft, creamy complexity and butterscotch nuances.

**Windy Peak Yarra Valley Chardonnay – Yarra Valley, Australia - Btl- 109.0/70.4 AUD/Gls – 30.0/19.4AUD**

Brioche-like fruit with hazelnut & white peach. Soft creamy flavours with balanced acidity & texture.

## Sauvignon Blanc

**Cape Mentelle Sauvignon Blanc Semillon – Margaret River, Western Australia** 169.0/109.2AUD

Citrus tones harmonized with snow peas and hints of blackcurrant on the nose before a zesty palate adds touches of wheat grass, a generous texture and well balanced finish.

**Blue Pyrenees Sauvignon Blanc - Victoria, Australia** 155.0/100.2AUD

The tropical fruit & salad greens make way for some mid palate creaminess & a strong mineral acid note, overall a soft fruit dry white.

**Craggy Range Te Muna Road Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, New Zealand** 151.0/97.6AUD

Pale straw colour with green hues. Fresh aromatics of white flowers, jasmine, nectarine and lime.

The palate is rich and wonderfully complex with an array of tropical fruits, refreshing acidity and a long chalky finish.

**Shaw Smith Sauvignon Blanc – Adelaide Hills, South Australia** 149.0/96.3AUD

Generous ripe gooseberry, passionfruit and tropical fruit flavours explode on the palate creating a mouth filling experience, followed by some citrus and spice nuances on the back palate, finish with long aftertaste of tropical fruit, passion fruit and gooseberry.

**Villa Maria Private Bin Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, New Zealand Btl – 119.0/76.9AUD/Gls – 32.0/20.7AUD**

Aromas of juicy passionfruit and limes burst from the glass with the mid palate adding fullness and length before finishing with a crisp and refreshing acidity.

## Riesling

**Pewsey Valley Riesling – Eden Valley, South Australia** 137.0/88.5AUD

Rich and intense, this classic riesling is flavoured by limes and tropical fruit before being finished with a soft natural acidity.

**Giesen Riesling – Marlborough, New Zealand Btl - 119.0/76.9AUD/ Gls – 32.0/20.7AUD**

Aromas of ripe lemon, grapefruit, spicy jasmine and a touch of ginger.

The palate has a succulent sweetness, mandarin zest and lemon curd flavours with a lovely drying acidity creating a luscious yet crisp finish.

## Varietals

**Peregrine Pinot Gris – Central Otago, New Zealand** 149.0/96.3AUD

A stunningly finished union of pear, quince, mango and stone fruit is well balanced with mouth filling flavours and a beautiful persistence.

**Saint Clair Godfrey's Creek Reserve Pinot Gris, – Brancott, New Zealand** 139.0/89.8AUD

This is an elegant, complex wine with delicate aromas of pears and apples. The palate is medium-bodied and ripe stone fruit flavours linger in a soft, refreshing finish.

**Lake Chalice Eyrie Vineyard Pinot Gris – Marlborough, New Zealand** 121.0/78.2AUD

Bright, pale straw colour with aromas of pear drops and almonds. A round soft palate, enhanced by having a small portion of the blend aged in oak barrels.

This adds a touch of spice to the full, rich finish.

## Rose

**Andrew Peace, Masterpeace Rose** – Victoria, Australia Btl -79.0/51.0AUD/gls – 20.5/13.2AUD

A delicate tinge of strawberry sweetness and raspberry overtones on the nose, this Rose's floral scent is perfect for summer.

## Shiraz

**Katnook Estate Shiraz** – Barossa Valley, South Australia 179.0/115.7AUD

The 2008 Vintage was mild and dry and produced Shiraz with abundant classic varietal characters of raspberry, plum, sweet spices and an underlying note of black pepper.

**Wirra Wirra Catapult Shiraz** – McLaren Vale, Australia 169.0/109.2AUD

Bright & juicy sweet fruit flood the palate with plum and blueberry dominating, enhanced by fine savoury tannins and bright mouth-watering acidity.

**Jim Barry Lodge Hill Shiraz** – Barossa Valley, South Australia 149.0/96.3AUD

An intense purple colour hints at a spicy aroma of cinnamon, pepper and liquorice. Spearmint, violets and boysenberry abound on a palate supported by soft tannins.

**Wynns Coonawarra Shiraz** – Coonawarra, South Australia 129.0/83.4AUD

Elegant fruit & spice character, with generous lashings of mulberries & blackberries, dusted with hints of black pepper & nutmeg.

**Taylor's Shiraz** – Clair Valley, South Australia Btl -119.0/76.9AUD/Gls – 31.0/20.0AUD

Rich, luscious and round with intense, perfectly ripened fruit characters. Roasted coffee bean and subtle spice characters complement the generous fruit flavours.

**Evans & Tate The Go Between Shiraz** - Margaret River, Western Australia 94.0/60.7AUD

This is a plush, fruit driven wine full of red berries with subtle spicy nuances. A generous wine packed full of character.

## Cabernet Sauvignon

**Wynns Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon** – Coonawarra, South Australia 199.0/128.6AUD

Rich and supple, with pristine flavours of blackcurrant and complex layers of minty Coonawarra Cabernet.

The creamy oak adds to the long, rich finish.

**Blue Pyrenees Cabernet Sauvignon** – Victoria, Australia 155.0/100.2AUD

Ripe blackcurrant fruit complimented by a choc-mint undergrowth and cedar oak flavours. Proudly medium bodied with classical Cabernet Sauvignon structure

**Yalumba Mawsons Cabernet Sauvignon** – Wrattobully, Australia Btl -122.0/78.8AUD/gls – 31.0/20.0AUD

Dark berries release a rich plummy aroma expertly blended with the sweet vanilla notes of well seasoned oak. A juicy palate is stylishly finished with soft plush tannins.

## Merlot

**Windy Peak Yarra Valley Cab Sauvignon Merlot** – Yarra Valley, Australia Btl – 109.0/70.4AUD/gls – 30.0/19.4AUD

Fragrant blackberry-like fruits with dark chocolate & hints of cedar.

**Lake Chalice Vineyard Selection Merlot** – Marlborough, New Zealand 121.0/78.2AUD

Displaying sensational varietal aromas of boysenberry and plums.

A medium bodied Merlot with vibrant fruit and supple tannins, with tones of chocolate and tobacco leaf and underlying spicy, toasty oak.

**Madfish Cabernet Merlot** – Margaret River, Australia 139.0/89.8AUD

This wine has a luscious smooth ripe flavour profile without being sweet with regional notes of black olives and eucalypt.

**Blue Pyrenees Merlot** - Victoria, Australia 155.0/ 100.2AUD

A vibrant mouthful of fresh plum like fruit complemented by forest floor flavours of mint leaves, earth and cedar wood. This Merlot is memorable for its fragrance and lingering bright fruit flavours.

## Pinot Noir

**Villa Maria Reserve Pinot Noir** – Marlborough, New Zealand 210.0/135.7AUD

A deep bouquet of dark red cherries and cloves dominate the nose while a refined and generous palate shows excellent balance and length complimented by fine tannins.

**Peregrine Pinot Noir** – Central Otago, New Zealand 199.0/128.6AUD

This award winning drop has a candied perfume of mocha and cherries, a rich and dense palate of plums, spice and silky tannins. You won't be disappointed

**Oyster Bay Pinot Noir** – Marlborough, New Zealand 114.0/73.7AUD

Fragrant cherry, ripe black plum and red berry fruits are accentuated with seductive savory notes then perfectly finished with svelte tannins.

## Dessert Wine

**D' Arenberg Noble Wrinkled Riesling** – McLaren Vale, Australia 99.0/64.0AUD

A very pretty and lifted nose with fruit characters of fresh apple, mixed peel and rose petals with a spicy background of star anise, cinnamon sticks and a hint of white pepper.
